ICEBERGS An iceberg is a floating mass of fresh water ice extending more than 5 m above the sea surface It may originate from a glacier flowing directly to the sea, such as the tidewater glaciers of Greenland, or from an ice shelf, such as those found in Antarctica Most icebergs appear white

Quantification and Analysis of Icebergs in a Tidewater ...

Tidewater glaciers are glaciers that terminate in, and calve icebergs into, the ocean In addition to the influence that tidewater glaciers have on physical and chemical oceanography, floating icebergs serve as habitat for marine animals such as harbor seals (*Phoca vitulina richardii*)
