Robert's Rules of Order: Voting on a Motion TYPES OF VOTES

One half of 81 votes = 405, since a majority is more than one half, the majority of votes would = 41 So for the motion to be carried, there would have to be at least 41 "yes" votes cast 2/3 VOTE Notice that it is not called a "2/3 Majority" A 2/3 vote is generally not taken as a voice vote, but rather as a Robert's Rules of Order: Voting
