THE RIDDLE IN TWELFTH NIGHT SIMPLIFIED Lee Sheridan Cox, in "The Riddle in Twelfth Nightw (SQ, XI11 [1962], 360), has ingeniously interpreted Maria's MOAI riddle to stand for "I am 0" (Olivia) However, Maria's "fustian riddle" is much more obvious ("coarser") than that, and its very simplicity better exposes Malvolio as a self-loving fool
